- Arrange Parent's Consultation Days, at which your child's progress will be discussed and current work can be viewed.
- Undertake to see you by appointment to discuss concerns, which have become apparent to you or the School about your child's work, attendance or behaviour or to investigate any complaints you have about any aspect of the School.
- Keep you regularly briefed about the life and work of the School through emailed information and the school notice board.
- Be open and welcoming and seek opportunities for you to be involved in the life of the school e.g. school trips and supporting the PTA.
