Dear Parents and Carers

Would you like up to £1600 worth of goods and services for free?

You are strongly encouraged to register for Free School Meals if you are in receipt of one or more of the listed benefits:

- Income Support (IS)
- Income Based Jobseekers Allowance (IBJSA)
- The Guarantee element of State Pension Credit
- An income-related employment and support allowance
- Support under part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Child Tax Credit, provided you not entitled to Working Tax Credit and an annual income does not exceed £16,190
- Working Tax Credit -during the four-week period immediately after your employment ceases, or after you start to work less than 16 hours per week
- Universal Credit

If you are unsure whether you qualify for an award, please submit an application form and Redbridge will contact you to let you know if you are in fact eligible. Anyone who feels their child may be entitled to Free School Meals should apply online at <http://bit.ly/2cz2B3T>. When connected to the page, click on 'Schools' followed by 'Free School Meals'. It takes only a few minutes to sign up. Alternatively, you can arrange to meet Rosette Doxon, our School Business Leader, who can offer advice and assistance in completing the form if you bring your documents into school.

We know that some families may be reluctant to enquire about eligibility for free school meals but we want to ensure that any child entitled to receive them can do so in an easy and discreet manner. Children are not identified to their peers as being in receipt of Free School Meals.

Don't miss out on this opportunity for up to £1600. The child does not have to take school dinners, but if a family is registered for Free School Meals they are also eligible for other discounts from school including: music lessons; trips; Breakfast Club; after school clubs and maths homework books.
