## Year 6 Visit to Rhos Y Gwaliau

**Sunday 17<sup>th</sup> June – Saturday 23<sup>rd</sup> June 2018 / Sunday 24<sup>th</sup> June – Saturday 30<sup>th</sup> June 2018.**

I am very pleased to inform you that we have now agreed the dates for all Year 6 classes to go to Rhos Y Gwaliau.

6Wk and 6wa will visit Rhos Y Gwaliau the week beginning Sunday 17<sup>th</sup> June 2018, returning on Saturday 23<sup>rd</sup> June 2018. Accompanied by Mrs Emeny as visit leader and Mr Warmoth, Mr Webster, Ms Edwards and Mr Bali.

6C and 6M will visit Rhos Y Gwaliau the week beginning Sunday 24<sup>th</sup> June 2018, returning on Saturday 30<sup>th</sup> June 2018. Accompanied by Mr Easter as visit leader and Ms Cooper, Miss McManus, Mr Kennedy and Ms Hawkins.

The coach will leave the school promptly at **9.30am** on Sunday 17<sup>th</sup> June and Sunday 23<sup>rd</sup> June 2018.

We will assemble in the car park or, in the event of rain, the hall. No vehicles will be allowed in the car park.

In order to ensure that your child is seated and prepared we would ask that they arrive at school on these days at **9.00am**.

There will be a luggage limit of 18kg.

Only one suitcase trolley or holdall will be allowed on the coach as space will be restricted. It is suggested that this is a bag with wheels.

A small plastic bag or day sack in which children may carry their own lunch and book or activity for the coach journey is allowed.

No electronic devices, mobile phone, sweets or fizzy drinks are allowed on the coach.

Please ensure that travel sickness medication is administered to your child if needed.

Children will be grouped with a member of school staff for the journey and escorted to the coach.

Please note that the coach may have to stop at the top of the road. So please do not obstruct the pavement or entrance points and be prepared to help in moving your child's suitcase.

The coach will depart **promptly at 9.30am on the Sunday**. There will be a half hour stop at a service station for lunch. Children will need to bring their own lunch in a disposable bag with a snack and drink bottle (no fizzy drinks please).

You may wish to ensure that your child has eaten a light breakfast prior to departure.

We are due to arrive at Rhos y Gwaliau between 3.45pm and 4pm. As soon as possible after arrival we will confirm our safe arrival on the school website. Please understand that we will not do this until your child is safely disembarked and settled. Safety is always our first priority.

### Return Journey Times

On the return journey children will leave Rhos y Gwaliau on either Saturday 23<sup>rd</sup> June 2018 or Saturday 30<sup>th</sup> June 2018.

The coach will depart at approximately 10.00am and should arrive at school between 3.30pm/3.45pm.

We will stop at a service station for a break half way. The children will be given a packed lunch and a drink.

All travel medication for the return journey must be clearly named, placed in a sealed envelope and given to the school office.

We will endeavour to update the school website if there are major delays on the homeward journey. This may be difficult due to wireless connections.

Children are always pleased to be reunited with their families at the end of the journey. A prompt pick up would be appreciated.

Please note: No mobile phones are allowed for the children or electronic games. The purpose of this trip is to promote independence.

We reserve the right to ask for any child to be collected from Rhos y Gwaliau should there be medical issues or concerns about their behaviour/conduct. All children need to be safely enabled to enjoy what promises to be an excellent week. Once the visit has commenced we reserve the right not to refund the money for the visit.
