In line with our healthy eating ethos, the children will need to bring their own healthy packed lunch and a bottle of water. We do not allow fizzy drinks to be taken on educational visits, and nut products are excluded due to allergies.

The children are required to wear correct school uniform. If taking a jumper/cardigan please ensure it is the correct school colour, navy blue. Please ensure your child has a suitable coat (no hoodies) and shoes if the weather conditions are poor.

Due to the educational nature of our visit, we will not visit the gift shop and we ask that children **do not** bring any money with them on the day. The class teachers will bring a camera to record the event – please ensure that personal cameras are left at home.
