Jewish Museum of London Trip

Dear Parents and Carers,

As part of our school's curriculum, it is important that all children have the opportunity to learn about the main world religions. During their time at Churchfields, pupils visit a church, a mosque and a temple to learn about some of the key principles and features of different religions.

As part of our unit of work on Judaism, pupils will be visiting the Jewish Museum of London in May for a half-day trip:

4C and 4K will visit on Monday 21st May 2018

4E and 4B will visit on Thursday 24th May 2018

(both trips should arrive back to school before 3pm)

They will explore why the Torah is central to Jewish life, how it is looked after and celebrated by people of the Jewish faith. They will learn about some of the stories in the Torah and the craft of the scribe. Pupils will experience handling artefacts that are used to make a Torah, among other activities. Children will not take part in Jewish religious ceremonies or say prayers because we respect that children in our school have different faiths.

The children will need to take their own packed lunch and bottle of water (no fizzy drinks or nut products due to allergies). We will be travelling on the Tube. The children do not need to bring any money and class teachers will bring a camera to record the day.

As usual, all pupils are required to wear school uniform and should have suitable coat and shoes to walk to and from the station even in wet weather.
