On **Friday 8<sup>th</sup> June**, our school will be hosting our first ever **Soccer Aid for Unicef Playground Challenge** and we very much hope that you will join us in supporting this active, fun and educational event. It is a great opportunity for our pupils to learn about and raise money for children in other parts of the world.

### What is it?

The Soccer Aid Playground Challenge will encourage pupils to kick, bounce or carry a football around an obstacle course on the school field. With just one week from this date before the 2018 FIFA World Cup, we encourage children to wear the colours of a competing team or their favourite football or sports kit.

### How can you help?
