As part of our work on Islam, Year 5 will be visiting East London Mosque on the following dates:

**5EK and 5S- Monday 9th July 2018**  
**5Ed and 5M- Thursday 12th July 2018**

Children will leave in the morning at 9.15am. We will be travelling to the mosque by tube for a Guided Tour and short question and answer session about Islam. The children will then travel back to eat their packed lunch at school. Please do not give your child any spending money as we will not visit any shops. Children need to dress in the correct school uniform or PE kit, in accordance with the dress code outlined (please see below).

PLEASE NOTE- The East London Mosque is a place of worship. Male and female visitors should not wear shorts, short skirts or short dresses. It is also a 'no shoe area,' so please bear in mind all visitors will be requested to place their shoes in racks before entering the mosque building. Female visitors will also need to cover their heads with a scarf or similar when in the building.
