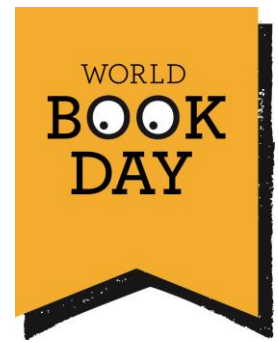

### World Book Day – Battle of the Books

Dear parent/carer,

We are very much looking forward to World Book Day on Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> March - especially due to the success of the Battle of the Books last year.

Like last year, on this day each class will have a Battle of the Books, in which every child brings to school their favourite book to read out their favourite part and tell their class why they think other children should read the book. All pupils will be given a World Book Day £1 voucher which they can use to buy a special £1 World Book Day book from local supermarkets or bookshops whilst availability lasts or use towards the purchase of any book from a bookshop.
