

## Key Vocabulary

<b>Leg Before Wicket</b>	The batsman obstructs the ball with the leg rather than the bat
<b>Over</b>	Six balls are bowled
<b>Spin</b>	To move the ball through the air with a revolving motion
<b>Caught and Bowled</b>	The bowler that has bowled the ball also catches the shot made by the batsman
<b>Bails</b>	Two pieces of wood that sit on the stump

## Positions


<b>Wicket Keeper</b>	A fielder who stands close and behind the batsman and uses the stumps.
<b>First Slip</b>	The fielding position closest to the wicket keeper.
<b>Gully</b>	To stand on the off side of the cricket square.
<b>Third Man</b>	To stand on the boundary rope in line with the wicket keeper.

## Skills

<b>Batting</b>	To use the action of hitting a ball with the bat
<b>Bowling</b>	To throw the ball over arm or underarm
<b>Fielding</b>	To stop or catch the ball from a fielding position

## Key Facts

<b>Cricket grounds</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Lord's, known as the Home of Cricket, is owned by Marylebone Cricket Club in London.</li> <li>● Headingley, in Leeds</li> <li>● Edgbaston, in Birmingham</li> <li>● The Oval, in London.</li> <li>● The world's largest cricket ground, the Motera is currently being built in Gurjarat, and will house 100,024 spectators. This will cover 63 acres.</li> </ul>
<b>Players</b>	Imran Khan was the captain of the Pakistan World Cup winning team in 1992. He is now the Prime Minister of Pakistan.
<b>Competitions</b>	The Ashes is a Test cricket series played between England and Australia. 2019 England won the Cricket World Cup at Lords beating New Zealand by a super over.



## Rules

1.	To get an opponent out by catching the ball, stumping, leg before wicket, running the player out or bowling
2.	You can score as many single runs, four runs or six runs
3.	A game must have two umpires stood at either end of the wicket
4.	The bowler must bowl six legal deliveries to constitute an over
5.	A test match is seen as the highest standard of cricket as it is a big test for players, because it lasts for five days with 90 overs each day.
