Advantage	When the score is tied the player that wins the next point has the advantage.
Break Point	When you are one point away from winning a game while your opponent serves.
Deuce	When both players have 40 points.
Let	When a serve is not a fault, the serve maybe taken again.
Love	When no point has been scored in a game.

Skills


Hitting	The racket makes contact with the ball as the player drives and swings the racket.
Serving	A shot used to start a point. A high ball toss is frequently used.
Slicing	To slice or spin the ball using low impact.

Shots

Backhand	To use the reverse of the racket across the body to hit the ball.
Forehand	To swing the racket across the body with the hand moving palm first.
Lob	To hit the ball high and deep in to the opponents court.
Volley	A shot is struck before it hits the ground.

Courts	The biggest arena in the world is the Arthur Ashe stadium which seats a capacity crowd of 23,200. The o2 is the biggest in England and that seats 17,500.
Players-n According to rankings	Roger Federer from Switzerland is the greatest male player of all time. Martina Navratilova has won the Wimbledon Ladies Singles title 9 times.
Grand Slam Tournaments	4 major competitions to win- Australian Open, French Open, US Open and Wimbledon. Played on clay, hard court and grass.



Rules

1.	Players cannot touch the net or cross over onto the opponent's side of the court.
2.	Players must wait until the ball passes the net on their side before they can return it.
3.	IMen have two win three sets and women have to win two.
4.	The player who was receiving in the last game of the first set will serve first in the second set. Serves alternate.
5.	New balls are used after every six games.
