What I know and can explain

I can read a wider range of poetry and texts with accuracy and at a reasonable speaking pace.

I can read further exception words, noting the unusual correspondences between spelling and sound, and where these occur in the word.

I can increase my familiarity with a wide range of books, including fairy stories, myths and legends, and retelling some of these orally.

I can question and challenge what I have read.

I can read books that are structured in different ways and reading for a range of purposes.

I can identify themes and conventions in a wide range of books.

I can discuss the content of a text.

I can recognise some different forms of poetry [for example, free verse, narrative poetry].

I can discuss my understanding of a text and explain the meaning of words in context.

I can predict what might happen from details stated and implied with greater clarity and precision.

I can identify main ideas drawn from more than one paragraph and summarise these.

I can identify how language, structure, and presentation contribute to meaning.

I can develop and justify inferences such as inferring characters' feelings, thoughts and motives from their actions.
